

How to Navigate Unfamiliar Airspace

We combined the most commonly asked questions about navigating some of the U.S.'s most challenging airspaces and packed the answers into one event. We'll review Restricted Airspace, Military Operations Airspace, Military Training Routes, VFR corridors, Washington DC airspace, as well as dissect airspaces that might appear intimidating on a Sectional Chart (but really aren't). By the end of the session, you'll have new preflight planning tools—and new levels of confidence—for navigating airspace that you have never flown into before.
