Ace Your Checkride! Top Tips from a DPE

Checkrides can be intimidating. So much to learn and so many skills to master. It's natural to feel nervous when you are about to undertake something as challenging as meaningful as a pilot checkride. But there are ways to make it less stressful.

Presenter Craig Thighe is a Denver area Designated Pilot Examiner and CFI. Craig will enlighten us on the checkride experience from the other side of the cockpit. He will talk with us about the role of the Examiner, including what they are and are not permitted to do during checkrides, and what they expect from applicants. He will share tips for passing your next ride, and humorous anecdotes about rides that didn't go according to plan.

All students and pilots who are planning to take a checkride in the near future are encouraged to attend.
