

iPad Fundamentals for Aviation

The iPad has become almost ubiquitous in the general aviation cockpit. Proficient use is key to maximize its utility. This starts with the fundamentals of operation.

This course covers the basics of iPad operation with a few tricks thrown in: from how you turn the device on, to how you make setting changes, creating shortcuts and folders, taking screen prints, updating and other tricks. We will discuss different ways to incorporate it into your flying regimen.
