

Mountain Flying - Know Before You Go

The core of safe mountain flying lies in density altitude awareness, proper ridge crossing techniques, flying the correct aircraft, look at weather cams, know how to manage your aircraft engines at higher altitude, and more. Join FAA Safety Team Representative Tom Slavonik for a lively discussion about mountain flying; don't wait until it's too late.

From US Highway 50 turn on Decker Drive at the COL Leo Sidney Boston War Memorial. Continue down Decker Drive for approximately 1/8 mile and follow around to the left where there is ample parking available. After parking your vehicle, walk towards the fence and enter through the pedestrian gate on the right, closest to the building. After walking through the gate, turn right and enter the building through the first door on the right. Continue all the way back to the Conference Room.
