

GA Pilots Recurrent Training -- FAA Wings Program

Professional Part 135 and 121 pilots accomplish Recurrent or Refresher training at least annually. The FAA requires GA pilots to accomplish a Flight Review at least every 24 months (or equivalent). That is where the Wings program comes into play. Instead of a Flight Review every 24 months continually prepare yourselves as Part 135 and 121 Professional pilots do. Learn how to sign up to achieve Wings credit and access to a wealth of aviation knowledge.
