A Message from Michael Huerta, FAA Administrator: The FAA and general aviation groups have launched an eight month Got Weather? national safety campaign to help general aviation (GA) pilots prepare for potential weather challenges they may encounter during the 2014 flying season. Are you prepared for the weather this flying season? Weather is the most lethal of all major causes of GA accidents. According to the Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA), nearly 75% of weather-related accidents are fatal. Increase Aeronautical Decision Making skills by discussing this vital subject with your peers.
