

Overcoming a Startled event - Preventing Loss of Control Inflight

We learn to fly maneuvers by repetition to gain what is generally called hand-eye-coordination. Once a skill is gained we find that the "work" of flying is minimized and we have "more fun." But what if an unexpected event occurs? We may become startled and freeze at the controls-exhibiting tunnel vision which may lead to losing control of the aircraft. How do you prepare for an unexpected event when you have no idea when it will occur?
