

Safe Decision Making and the Pilot thought Process.

Discussed in this program is the relentless threat to aviation safety as well as the central preoccupation of aviation Human Factors: Human Error. This program looks into human error from a different perspective (as viewed by the pilot) when compared with the views favored by “traditional” Human Factors, after the fact by the investigator. The mechanisms of individual human error are sought to be understood, so that measures to minimize the possibility of its appearance can be devised.
