The FAA established the *WINGS* Pilot Proficiency Program to reduce the number of preventable aviation accidents. WINGS promotes ongoing flight training with an authorized flight instructor. By using the WINGS program as a framework for your training, pilots can improve their skills and knowledge to create a safer flying experience. This seminar will provide an overview of the WINGS program, how to navigate the website, and how to award credits with an emphasis on CFI roles.
