# **A Class D Airspace Briefing by the TTD Tower Chief**

At this month's Second Saturday, we'll be getting a Class D Briefing with Troutdale Tower Air Traffic Manager David Langford. Pilots in our flying region should keep their Class D skills sharp due to the several Class Delta airports within easy reach of the Aurora State Airport. These include Troutdale, Hillsboro, Salem, and Eugene Airports. David will review basic Class D procedures, including the critical arrival and departure phases, with a specific look at Troutdale and its relationship to Portland's Class C boundary. We'll be donating a portion of this year's Second Saturday proceeds to the Civil Air Patrol on behalf of our pilot community.

**Directions:** DRIVE IN - Two miles south of Wilsonville, just off I-5. 1/4 mile south of Arndt Rd.FLY IN - Taxi to the very north end of the Aurora airport. Park on the ramp between the fuel island and the FBO building. AVOID OVERFLYING POPULATED AREAS.
