

ATC Radar and Emergency Services Available to Pilots

Discussing ATC radar services and Emergency services is a valuable lesson for pilots, allowing them the ability to take advantage of ATC to successfully complete flights as part of their training curriculum and personal flight operations. Many pilots with limited experience talking to controllers on the approach/center and the control towers frequencies often act as though this interaction is a nuisance to their flight operations. However using ATC services and knowing how they can be used correctly increases a pilot's ability to safely complete a flight.
