

Topic of the Month for February, 2015 - Personal Minimums

NTSB accident data suggest that pilot capability is not simply a matter of certification level and experience but rather that a wide variety of conditions and circumstances can influence pilot performance. This seminar discusses variability in performance and examines the argument that pilots should develop personal minimums, and how those minimums should be reviewed and adjusted with respect to existing conditions and circumstances.
