

Situational Awareness - A critical human factor of flight

Approximately 85% of all GA accidents are attributed to pilot error. Situational Awareness (or SA) is a critical human factor for safe flight. We will watch an FAA video on SA and discuss the three levels of SA, the common factors that degrade SA, and how to improve your SA.
