

# Forensic Reconstruction - Going Beyond NTSB Aircraft Accident Investigations

There are four typical repeated GA accident events that will be used as case in presentation to underscore decision-making failures that result in accidents. (1) seat slips on Cessna 100-200 series rails, (2) GA engine carburetor failures (3) in-flight fires in engine compartments (4) stall spin scenario due to loss of tail plane authority.

**Directions:** Fly-In: Ground transportation will be provided between Gorge Aviation and the college starting at 9:00 AM. From Interstate 84, take Exit 85 to The Dalles. Follow The Dalles City Center signs and proceed south about 1 block. Turn right at stop sign (free turn), and go about 1 block. Keep left on the round-about and take the second right exit up Brewery Grade. At the top of the hill, turn right onto Dry Hollow Road. Follow Dry Hollow Road to the second stop sign, which is East 16th place. (A grade school is located to your left.) Turn right and travel one short block, then turn left onto Scenic Drive. Follow Scenic Drive 3/4 mile to CGCC entrance sign.
