Additional Seats High Altitude Hypoxia Training CHAMBER
Sunday April 10th 2016

You will have the opportunity to discover your hypoxia symptoms first-hand in CAMI's Portable Reduced Oxygen Training Enclosure (PROTE) system. The 20 minute Chamber flights run throughout the day.

While attending the Hypoxia Seminar is not required to participate in the chamber, attendance in the class is recommended. Each flight is limited to five people. To qualify for the Hypoxia Chamber flights you must be at least 18 years old and have a current 3rd Class, or higher, Medical.

To receive the FAA Form 3150-1, PHYSIOLOGICAL TRAINING, commonly referred to as the Blue Card, at the conclusion of the Chamber exercise you must attend one of the CAMI Hypoxia Awareness Seminars on Friday Apr 8th or Saturday Apr 9th.
