Making Fewer Decisions in Flight--Creating Your Own Rules to Live By

Aeronautical Decision Making is all the rage. Pilots are continually striving to make better decisions in flight to produce a more predictable, safer outcome. Unfortunately, general aviation continues to have a significantly higher accident rate than commercial aviation. This seminar will consider the following question: Would we be better served by making fewer decisions in flight? Observing that commercial operations are more strictly regulated, restricting commercial pilots to fewer decisions they are allowed to make in flight, we will consider adopting variations of Part 121 and 135 flight rules as our own personal rules to live by.

Directions: From the Redmond Airport entrance, proceed north on SE Airport Way and turn right (East) onto SE Veterans Way. Proceed around the north end of the airport and turn right onto SE Sisters Ave. to continue around the periphery of the airport. Turn right into the first parking lot past gate D-4. Leading Edge Jet Center is on the right.
