Flying an airplane is a lot of fun, but when you're managing everything by yourself, it can get tough. Learn some tips and tricks for making the cockpit safer, ensuring you stay ahead of the airplane and maintaining situational awareness when you're PIC.

There is no one right answer in aeronautical decision-making. Each pilot is expected to analyze each situation in light of experience level, personal minimums, and current physical and mental readiness level, and make his or her own decision.

Directions: DRIVE IN - Two miles south of Wilsonville, just off I-5. 1/4 mile south of Arndt Rd.
FLY IN - Taxi to the very north end of the Aurora airport. Park on the ramp between the fuel island and the FBO building.
AVOID OVERFLYING POPULATED AREAS.
