And that means pilots who understand risk management fly for years without accidents or incidents, and with a bare minimum of "never again" moments.

At this month's two hour Second Saturday Seminar, we'll discuss the Five Hazardous Attitudes that can lead pilots astray, with an emphasis on rapid recognition, as well as the effective use of "antidote" behaviors that will keep you and your passengers safe.
