

Review Airport Safety and Operations at the Aurora State Airport

Aurora State Tower Chief Raul Suarez will drop by to discuss **Airport Operations**, with a specific focus on lessons learned over the past 12 months by the Local Runway Safety Action Team (LRSAT). Runway incursions and Vehicle/Pedestrian Deviations (VP/Ds) are always a high-priority safety topic, and we'll hear from the team on what we can do as pilots to keep these to an absolute minimum. We also expect to get tips on how pilots should interact with the tower for **effective communication**, and we'll be sure to take your questions as well. Don't miss this one!
