Flying?

Use a current airport/taxiway diagram and [check NOTAMs](#).

Taxi to the main ramp to park. Exit through the terminal building or gate. Walk to the hangar via the road.

I limited plane parking by the FAA Chapter 617 Hangar. Please do not block *any* hangars!

Please follow the [Central Oregon Area Flight Safety Considerations](#) and fly safe, predictable and legal pattern operations. All runways are left traffic at S39.

Driving?

Exit the OR-126 roundabout onto Tom McCall Road, then a quick left onto SW Aviation Blvd.

Drive ahead and then around the right-hand curve to the stop sign. FAA Chapter 617 hangar is in front of you, slightly to the left. Please do not block *any* hangars!
