In this seminar we will familiarize pilots with the 2023 update of AviationWeather.Gov and it's useful features. We will refresh basic knowledge around weather products and what to expect when flying through forecasted fronts, pressure systems, and hazardous weather. A hypothetical cross-country flying scenario will be used to practice weather planning, flight planning, risk assessment and decision making.
