

The Advanced Preflight - Helping Ensure Your Aircraft is Airworthy, Before You Leave the Ground!

The "Advanced Preflight Inspection" refers to conducting a preflight that goes beyond the normal preflight checklist. This is accomplished by gaining aircraft specific maintenance history, getting your hands on the aircraft and developing additional items to check during your inspection. Don't wear your good clothes to this presentation!

Directions: Enter the hangar area through the gate at N. Bradley Road. Follow the signs to the Pemberton's hangar. Use caution for taxiing airplanes and do not enter the airport's "movement area".
