

The Art of Getting Dirty, or What is Now Called 'The Advanced Preflight' + WINGS Explained

The advanced preflight concentrates your preflight review of the aircraft's logs and paperwork, plus the physical inspection of the aircraft. Where do you find this paper trail of aircraft history and what do you do with it when you find it? Teams will preflight a marked airplane to see how good their preflight really is. A review of the WINGS Program will keep the other teams busy while one team preflights the aircraft.

Directions: From I-82 take the Union Gap Exit. Go straight through the three round-a-bouts and drive West on Union Gap Blvd. Turn left on 3rd Avenue. Turn right on Ahtanum. Turn right at 21st Avenue. Turn in the first gate on the right.
