

ADS-B from A to Z

ADS-B requirements and services for the pilot will be explained. This will include the ADS-B 2020 mandate for General Aviation aircraft, and the services and limitations of inflight traffic and weather reporting that are provided to pilots via both certified and portable equipment. ADS-B will be compared to other systems. What is ADS-B? Do GA pilots need or want ADS-B? Certified installed equipment vs portable equipment? Can this replace my subscription for XM weather? When should I do something?
