Civil Air Patrol/FAASteam 2012 National Safety Stand Down

For Civil Air Patrol (CAP) members and guests ONLY. This year's FAASTeam Safety Stand Down focuses on Loss of Control. Loss of Control In-Flight was the dominant cause of fatal general aviation accidents over the last decade. Loss of Control refers to accidents resulting from situations in which the pilot should have either maintained or regained control of the aircraft, but did not. CAP pilots join the thousands of other pilots across the country in attending this exciting briefing!

Directions: From Eglin's East Gate (Val-p / Niceville) make a right at the 3rd traffic light onto 7th Street. From Eglin's West Gate (Shalimar) make a left at the second traffic light onto 7th Street. Once on 7th Street, continue to the top of the hill to the stop sign. Turn left at the stop sign onto Choctawhatee Ave. Building 38 will be on the left, at the corner of Choctawhatee Ave and Florida Ave. Parking is behind the building.
