

Marvel of Flight-WINGS and Things in DeFuniak Springs: Thunderstorms and ADM

To a pilot, the cumulonimbus clouds are the most dangerous. If a aircraft enters a thunderstorm the aircraft could experience updraft and downdrafts, exceeding 3,000 feet per minute. Moreover, thunderstorms can produce large hailstones, heavy rain, damaging lightning and tornadoes. The best rule for pilots is to circumnavigate and avoid all thunderstorms. Fly-in, 8:00 AM pancake breakfast, Young Eagles, static displays, car show, live music, helicopter rides, children activities and much more.

Directions: From I-10: Take exit 85, then north on Hwy 331. Turn left on Hwy 90. Turn left again on Gene Hurley Rd. From Hwy 285: Turn Right on Hwy 90. Then right on Gene Hurley Rd. Follow signs to the Marvel of Flight. Hangar #621
