FAASTeam Lead Rep Bill Castlen shares his experiences in using the Stormscope and NEXRAD in-cockpit resources for thunderstorm avoidance. He will show you interesting comparisons of these systems "looking" at the same storm activity - even including looking out the windshield!

Directions: Drive southbound on Highway 231 from Florida Welcome Center 8 miles. Turn left on County Road 162/Jacob Road and travel 9.5 miles, then turn right on County Road 167/Old US Road and travel 4.2 miles. Then right on FL-166/Caverns Road. Citizens Lodge will be about 4 miles on the left. Watch for the "FAA Safety Meeting" signs.
