VFR into IMC accidents are rarely the result of one bad decision. They develop through subtle weather changes, plan continuation bias, and delayed turn-around decisions. This seminar examines how VFR pilots unintentionally enter instrument conditions, the warning signs that are often ignored, and the human factors that keep pilots pressing on.
