**Directions:** Directly across from Eagle Aviation on John N. Hardee Expy, turn onto Lexington Dr, go 482 ft. Turn left onto Kentucky Ave, go 0.3 mi Turn left onto Service Rd, go 266 ft. Turn right into Destination. Right by the round weather radar dome.

If arriving from the North from Platt Springs Road, go around the traffic circle, stay right and take first road to right which is Kentucky Ave.
