

## Understanding Impairment Risk

...42% of pilots in fatal crashes had some sort of drug/medications in their systems during the flight. Some of these medications carry very specific warnings not to perform tasks requiring alertness. Combinations of prescriptions and OTC medications can be particularly dangerous.
