From Kershaw, drive North on US 601 to join US 9 in Pageland. Continue on US 9 through Pageland to Airport Road, State Road S-13-43. Turn right onto Airport Road and proceed to Clarence Jordan Lane (just prior to runway). Turn right onto Clarence Jordan Lane. The Airport FBO, 167

Airport Road, is the gray house left side of road.
