Lasting 10 to 15 minutes and followed by group discussion of the concepts presented, this presentation acquaints the audience with the hazards of inaccurate aircraft performance expectations and best practices associated with predicting aircraft performance including topics such as: faulty performance expectations human and some technology-centered performance calculation solutions weight and balance limitations the 50/70 rule of thumb creating a personal safety margin briefing each and every takeoff, approach, and landing

This event will be followed by a 30-40 minute presentation regarding best taxi practices, avoiding runway incursions, and a review of runway signs and markings. Wings participants are urged to register for both events separately.
