

SC FSDO FAAS Team presents:

Cooper River Bridge Run - Public Safety and Government Entity UAS Briefing

Federal Aviation Regulations prohibit the unsafe or unauthorized operation of an aircraft, including drones. Unsafe operations may result in substantial civil penalties and possible action against an operator's FAA-issued certificate, or may be subject to criminal response by law enforcement in accordance with local laws and ordinances.

FAAS Team personnel will review the registration requirements for drone operations as well as the operational requirements for the recreational and Part 107 UAS operator.

FAAS Team personnel will underscore that the law enforcement officer is in the best position to deter, detect and investigate unsafe or unauthorized drone operations.

FAAS Team personnel will provide support materials as well.
