Topic of the Month - Aircraft Performance and Calculations

The General Aviation Joint Steering Committee (GAJSC) has analyzed a number of General Aviation accidents having a common cause; accidents due to inaccurate and /or unreasonable expectations with regard to aircraft performance. These accidents are occurring in the takeoff and initial climb (departure) phases of flight and are likely to be fatal.

This presentation will refresh GA pilots knowledge of critical aircraft performance parameters and the importance of accurately predicting aircraft performance - particularly with a loss of power in the Takeoff and departure flight phases.

Directions: from I-77, Exit 82C westbound on Celanese [highway 161] continue until you see the airport on the right, then turn right at the stoplight onto Museum Road, Continue North past the fire station then bear right onto Airport road paralleling the runway,, Turn right into the Terminal Building parking lot.

From York, proceed eastbound on Route 161. Just past the Walmart shopping center on the right, the highway splits. Stay to the left through the stoplight (the other highway on the right at the split is 901). Continue eastbound past Rawleson Road, past the Cemetery on the left. approaching the stoplight there is a shopping center on the left. At the light turn left onto Museum Road, past the National Guard facility on the right, Continue North past the fire station then bear right onto Airport road paralleling the runway. Turn right into the Terminal Building parking lot.
