# **TRUST - Test and Airspace for Recreational UAS Operators**

<p>The Reauthorization Act of 2018 and 49 USC 44809: Exception for Limited Recreational Operations of Unmanned Aircraft created specific rules and limitations for Recreational UAS Pilots. In this presentation we will discuss TRUST, The Recreational UAS Safety Test, Define Recreational Flying, Operational Rules for Recreation Pilots, Registering your UAS, Approved Areas for Operation, and Controlled Airspace Authorizations. We will discuss some differences in Recreational Flying and Commercial UAS Operations.</p>
