

June Topic of the Month - Non-Required Safety Equipment

Plan for the unexpected and you'll be a better and safer pilot. Fortunately, the general aviation aftermarket parts industry has some creative and effective options that could enhance your safety and that of your passengers. This seminar outlines how and why some of these additions to your airplane might make sense when you do a fair cost to survival benefit analysis.
