Follow US-1 S into Lexington. At the intersection of Rt 378, continue straight ahead onto Old Chapin Rd and then make a left turn into the Flight Deck parking lot in 500 ft. The Flight Deck Restaurant is in the center of the shopping complex. The entrance is easily found off the courtyard near Barnes Jewelers and Horizon Travel.
