Event Details

Controlled Flight Into Terrain (CFIT) continues to happen despite technological advances. Why do perfectly good airplanes run into the ground? In this seminar, we'll look at some typical accidents and discuss the causes and strategies to avoid this happening to you. Through a better understanding of equipment and human limitations we'll all Fly Safer!

From CAE, head south on Airport Blvd. Take the right onto Air Commerce Dr. and then right onto SC-602. Turn left onto Ermine Rd. In 1.5 miles, turn left onto US-1 S/Augusta Rd. Follow US-1 S into Lexington. At the intersection of Rt 378, continue straight ahead onto Old Chapin Rd and then make a left turn into the Flight Deck parking lot in 500 ft. The Flight Deck Restaurant is in the center of the shopping complex. The entrance is easily found off the courtyard near Barnes Jewelers and Horizon Travel.
