Directions: The Orlando Apopka airport is approximately 3 miles north of Hwy 429 interchange on Hwy 441. Turn off State Rd 441, Orange Blossom Trail, on to Apopka Airport Rd. Cross the railroad tracks keep right up the hill to the airport. Parking is on the left and in the vacant lot NE of Hangar 9.
