Rock will discuss P-factor and over banking tendencies of an airplane as well as some of the common pilot errors that have resulted in accidents. He will also discuss checklist use, the need for performance charts and stall spin accidents. He will cover a little bit of instrument flying and how we stay on the elusive glide slope.

Directions: The Florida Air Museum Pavilion is located at the entrance to the SUN 'n FUN Fly-In campus. From Interstate 4, take County Line Road (Exit 25) south approximately 3.6 miles to Medulla RD / Old Medulla Rd. Turn left on Medulla Rd/Old Medulla Road, and proceed approximately 1.6 miles to the Florida Air Museum on the left. From Highway 60, take County Line Road north approximately 3.8 miles to Medulla RD / Old Medulla Rd. Turn right on Medulla Rd/Old Medulla Road, and proceed approximately 1.6 miles to the Florida Air Museum on the left. From Lakeland take Pipkin Road west to Medulla Road, turn right and proceed about ½ mile to the Florida Air Museum on the right.
