Directions: From I-4, take Exit 25 / County Line Rd south. Go ~4 mi to a left turn (east) onto Medulla Rd. Proceed east on Medulla ~2 mi til reaching a sharp right bend in the road, marked by an old red/white/blue jet on a pedestal. Proceed straight through the chain link gate onto S-n-F campus and park in the grassy area just inside the gate, adjacent to the former Florida Air Museum, now known as the Aerospace Center for Excellence (ACE). The venue is the Eickhoff Conference Room, on the second floor of the ACE building.
