Risk Management in General Aviation - an innovative approach

Two time Oshkosh FFAST team speaker, Ray Heyde, will lead a lively, entertaining, thought provoking, and yet informative presentation on the risks encountered by all pilots regardless of experience or skill level. Risk exposure on every flight contains both known and unknown elements. The hour long session will look at both “how and why” any pilot can arrive at a point of high risk on a given flight. Arriving at that point can be the result of simply not caring, not fully understanding the circumstances, lack of being prepared, lack of valid information, equipment failure, or just plain old bad luck. Understanding the elements of a go/no go decision, regulatory considerations, along with personal and other limitations will assist in a reduction of risk exposure. The course will look at several real life events that present learning tools for all levels of pilots’ skills to assist in avoiding both short term and long term consequences.

Directions: The FAA Aviation Safety Center is located on the SUN 'n FUN Fly-In campus. From Interstate 4, take County Line Road (Exit 25) south approximately 3.6 miles to Medulla RD / Old Medulla Rd. Turn left on Medulla Rd/Old Medulla Road, and proceed approximately 1.6 miles to the SUN 'n FUN Campus entrance. Proceed straight ahead on Doolittle Road and turn left onto Sun 'n Fun Road just before the closed airport gate. Continue on SUN 'n FUN road and make a left on Laird Road, the FAA Aviation Safety Center is on your right, park on the West side of the building – not on the grass. From Highway 60, take County Line Road north approximately 3.8 miles to Medulla RD / Old Medulla Rd. Turn right on Medulla Rd/Old Medulla Road, and proceed approximately 1.6 miles to the SUN 'n FUN Campus entrance. Then follow the directions above. From Lakeland take Pipkin Road west to Medulla Road, turn right and proceed about ½ mile to the SUN 'n FUN Campus entrance on the right.....then follow the directions above. Fly-in: Request taxi to SUN 'n FUN Campus. Park in front of FAA Safety Center Building on the grass. After the event, staff will be available to open SUN 'n FUN Campus gate for exiting onto airport.
