

Night Flying Safety Tips

The phenomenon of night poses a risk for all pilots regardless of experience but the inexperienced pilot is especially at risk. 72% of our flying information comes through the eye and the eye is easily fooled at night. The darker the night, the absence of a horizon and lack of recency are danger signals. We will also discuss how to locate airports and find runways at night!!

Directions: From Orlando area take Hwy 441 north thru Apopka toward Zellwood. 3 miles past Plymouth turn left into airport located along 441
From Mt. Dora area take Hwy 441 south thru Zellwood drive past airport on right to first right turn into airport entrance
