Pilots and passengers can do a lot to improve their chances of survival simply by making smart choices and being informed. Gary will also share information from the Air Force Rescue Coordination Center (AFRCC) where all Search and Rescue missions in the Continental United States are dispatched.

Directions: From Orlando area take Hwy 441 north thru Apopka toward Zellwood. 3 miles past Plymouth turn left into airport located along 441
From Mt. Dora area take Hwy 441 south thru Zellwood drive past airport on right to first right turn into airport entrance
