We will also review communication with ground control, communication while in the pattern and enroute along with communication procedures at towered and non towered airports.

We will also discuss VFR Lost communication procedures and light gun signals at towered airports.

From Mt. Dora area take Hwy 441 south thru Zellwood drive past airport on right to first right turn into airport entrance
