# **A Stabilized Approach is what you want**

Focusing on establishing and maintaining a stabilized approach and landing is a great way to avoid experiencing a loss of control. A stabilized approach is one in which the pilot establishes and maintains a constant angle glidepath towards a predetermined point on the landing runway. It is based on the pilot's judgment of certain visual clues, and depends on the maintenance of a constant descent airspeed and configuration. Whether you're a CFI, a student pilot, or anything in between the GAJSC's Loss of Control Working Group has some teaching points to help brush up on stabilized approach and landing techniques.

Come join the discussion with your fellow aviators and learn what they do to accomplish stabilized approaches. This seminar will offer you 1 Knowledge Credit for your WINGS phase and will serve as the monthly IMC Club meeting.
