

Standardization Why Bother?

This presentation is a very frank but also light hearted discussion of the importance of standardization in aircraft operation. We'll open with some aviation and non-aviation examples (very embarrassing examples) of what can happen when you either don't have standards, or willfully not comply with the standards you do have. We then discuss the successes and failures we saw when FlightSafety teamed up to standardize training and flight operations with another OEM, and how lessons we learned can help in developing true standardization in your own flight operations. We end with a step by step process in how best to proceed once the decision is made to truly standardize your flight operations.
