# AOPA Rusty Pilot Seminar at SnF Campus

Life may have gotten in the way, but the dream of flight can be yours again. Returning to the skies is not as difficult as most rusty pilots think. We're inviting you back into the cockpit and will help you get there. No FAA checkride or test involved! The seminar is free, satisfies the ground component of a flight review, and completes one Knowledge task of Basic FAA WINGS. Pre-registration is encouraged but not required. AOPA members: please pre-register on-line at <https://www.aopa.org/training-and-safety/lapsed-pilots>; find the scrolling seminar schedule on the right side of the screen, scroll to this specific event, and follow prompts to pre-register.

**Directions:** From I-4, take Exit 25 / County Line Rd south. Go ~3 1/2 mi to a left turn (east) onto Medulla Rd. Proceed east on Medulla ~1 1/2 mi til reaching a sharp right bend in the road, marked by an old red/white/blue jet on a pedestal. Proceed straight through the chain link gate onto S-n-F campus and continue east ~0.2 mi, then turn left onto Sun-N-Fun Rd. Proceed another 0.2 mi north to the FAA Safety Center, 4425 Sun-N-Fun Rd. The FAA Safety Center is across the street from the Cessna pavilion. Please park on the west side of the building.
