Obtaining your Remote Pilot Certificate and a discussion on Loss of Control

You've been reading articles everyday about Drones (UAVs). What exactly is a Drone and do I need a Pilot's License to fly one? Come learn the FAA requirements, safety issues, and the benefits and opportunities available when you have your Remote Pilot Rating. We will discuss the testing requirements for non-pilot and licensed pilots, and how to get your Remote Pilot's certificate. You'll learn how to register your UAV with the FAA, and new definitions relating to UAV operations, such as RP PIC, VO, VLOS and what the UAV maintenance requirements and medical requirements are. Bring your friends who aren't pilots, but would like to learn about flying drones.

Loss of Control continues to have a major impact on aviation safety. Between 2008 and 2014, about 47 percent of fatal fixed-wing GA accidents in the United States involved pilots losing control of their aircraft in flight. Statistically, approach to landing, maneuvering, and climb are the deadliest phases of flight for loss of control accidents. We will discuss what we mean by Loss of Control (LOC), look at some common examples and learn some tips on what we can do as pilots to minimize the risk of Loss of Control. As always, attendee participation is welcome and encouraged.
