

# The Human Startle Response and Managing Unexpected Events

This 2-hour presentation acquaints the audience with the human startle response and discusses best practices regarding management of unexpected events. The study of the startle response is a relatively new endeavor in accident prevention and analysis, and is thought to be a contributing human factor in many accidents and incidents. Come see what startle response is all about and learn what you can do to control it in the cockpit!
